4. Manly Hospital site process and possible uses

Denise advised that the Project Steering Group continue to meet monthly, the first Tuesday morning of the month and a meeting is scheduled for 3 July 2018.

6. Alcohol Free Zone review by Council.

• East and West Esplanade. The meeting noted concern that it appears West Esplanade is outside the alcohol-free zone area. West Esplanade has historically always been 24 hours alcohol free and must remain so. The forum has grave concerns the appalling antisocial drinking behaviour exhibited at East Esplanade will flow over to West Esplanade. The forum will monitor this issue and take any necessary steps to ensure West Esplanade is not allowed to turn into an area like East Esplanade.
